

LIVERMORE-AMADOR SYMPHONY
Updated Covid Policy
August 8, 2022

The Livermore-Amador Symphony (LAS) will always comply with current Alameda County Health mandates and recommendations plus any additional rehearsal and performance venue health requirements.

LAS specific Covid policies for the 2022-23 season as of August 8, 2022 are listed below and are subject to review and change at any time. Any changes will always be clearly communicated via email and posted on our website as far in advance as is reasonably possible.

1. LAS currently requires all musicians to wear masks indoors at all times, with soloists, woodwind, and brass players permitted to remove masks only when actively playing their instruments in rehearsal and performance.

2. To begin the 2022-23 season, LAS will align with the Alameda County Department of Public Health and CDC in strongly recommending that all participating musicians be fully up to date with vaccinations, defined here by the CDC: https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/stay-up-to-date.html?s_cid=11747:cdc%20fully%20vaccinated%20definition:sem.ga:p:RG:GM:gen:PTN:FY22 . Because of the highly individualized circumstances and timing of a person's vaccination schedule, LAS will no longer track and require proof of vaccination status at this time.

3. Please inform orchestra manager Bryan Waugh and your section leader if you are feeling ill and must miss rehearsal. Even without symptoms, if you have any concerns about your Covid status, please take a home test before attending rehearsal. If you test positive for Covid 19 after attending a rehearsal, please immediately inform Bryan Waugh. LAS will not share your name with others, but will inform musicians who were in attendance at that rehearsal and would be considered close contacts. You may return to rehearsal after completing proper isolation and testing procedures, and after communication about this with LAS.
